

Year 11 GCSE Results 2016

The Key Stage 4 performance measures for schools have changed. There are 4 key measures and they are as follows:

- Progress 8 - this is a score that measures our students against similar students nationally across 8 key subjects. A Progress 8 score of 0 would be expected overall progress for our Year 11 students. Year cohorts differ from year to year, which is reflected in Progress 8 calculations
- Attainment 8 – this is the average grade that students achieve across 8 key subjects
- Percentage of students who achieve A*-C in English and Maths
- English Baccalaureate (EBacc) – the percentage of students who achieve A*-C grades in English, Maths, 2 Sciences, a language and either History or Geography

The results for these key measures are given below. As parents are currently familiar with the 5A*-C including English and Maths measure, we have shown that as well. We have also provided some comparisons over time on the key measures and on other grades too.
